

Summer Program Literacy Assessment Report

The Summer Program Assessment is a tool for you to track your students' literacy progress. Use the assessment at the beginning and end of your summer program.

Materials: Stopwatch, pen/pencil

Directions: Each assessment will be 60 seconds long. Make sure the student understands the instructions before beginning the appropriate assessment. Please allow the student time to figure out the word by themselves. If they spend too much time on any one word/phrase, skip to the next and mark the skipped word.

Grades K-1

Assessment 1 – Alphabet Test: This is the first assessment for kindergarteners. Use the stopwatch to time how many letters the student can identify correctly in 60 seconds. If the student can name all 26 letters, please move onto Assessment #2.

Assessment 2 – Fast Words Test: The Fast Words Test is for 1st graders or for K'ers who passed the Alphabet Test. With the stopwatch, time how many words the student can read correctly in 60 seconds. If the 1st grader can read the entire list with 0 mistakes, move onto Assessment 3.

Assessment 3 – Speedy Phrases Test: Determine how many phrases the student can read correctly in 60 seconds.

Grades 2-3

Assessment 4 – High Frequency Words Test: For 2nd Graders only. Determine how many words the student can read correctly in 60 seconds.

Assessment 5 – Story Test: For 3rd Graders only. Determine how much of the story the student can read in 60 seconds by counting number of correct words read.
